WARNINGS:

Failure to follow set up instructions and use of this product in a manner other than directed could result in injury. Keep instructions for future use. Do not use this product in a bed that is near a window with cords or drapes which may strangle a child.



DO NOT LEAVE INFANTS UNATTENDED

Infants who cannot get in and out of an adult bed without help can be trapped between a mattress and a wall or headboard and suffocate. Do not use the infant co-sleeper in a bed with soft bedding which can cause suffocation. Infants that are able to push up on their hands and knees or weigh 15 lbs. or more can crawl over the infant co-sleeper if not being properly supervised. Even when your child is asleep, you must still provide the supervision necessary for the continued safety of your child.

Keep foam out of direct sunlight which causes the foam to dry out and disintegrate. Discard foam if it becomes dry and begins to disintegrate.

CLEANING & STORAGE:

Foam can be surfaced cleaned with a lint roller or soapy damp cloth . Keep foam out of direct sunlight. Avoid compression or folding of the foam for storage longer than one month. Store out of reach of children when not in use.

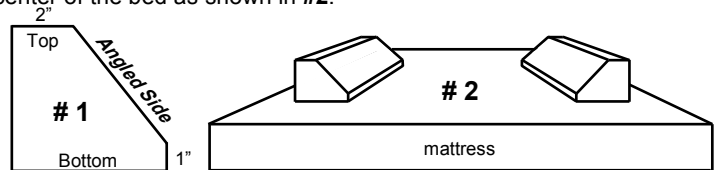

Child Bed Guard Rail

The Bed Bug Bumper™ works best when placed directly on top of the mattress. All other bedding should go over the bumper. This will minimize any movement of the Bed Bug Bumper™. There must be a fitted sheet or mattress cover over the Bed Bug Bumper™ for it to stay in place. If your bedding is very tight, use a deep pocket fitted sheet or sheet clips (available at bed & bath stores).

Place the bumper at least 9 inches from the headboard and footboard; and 3 inches in from the side edge (or bead) of the mattress between the child and the edge of the bed. Position with the *Angled Side* facing up and in toward the child. (See #1 which shows the end view of a bumper and indicates the *Angled Side*) After the mattress pad and bottom fitted sheet are placed over the Bed Bug Bumper™, re-adjust the foam bumper so that it sits flat with the angled sides facing up and in toward the center of the bed as shown in #2.

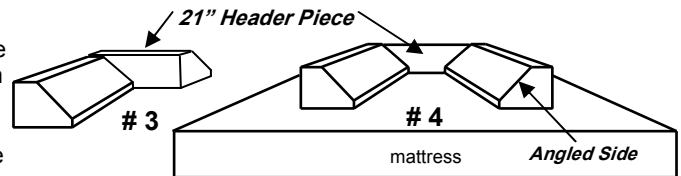
Toddler Beds—If your toddler bed utilizes a crib mattress and a tight fitting crib sheet, you may cut the bumper to a shorter length and position the bumper angled side down to help the bumper fit under the sheet. Also, the Bed Bug Bumper™ can slip out of place on a vinyl covered mattress. It is recommended that you purchase a non-slip pad from www.gobedbug.com or apply self-stick felt to the vinyl mattress under the full length and width of the bumper.



Infant Co-Sleeping - Read warnings above

Follow instructions above for the Toddler/Child Bed Guard Rail and *in addition*:

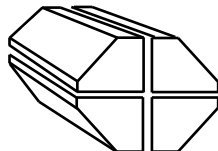
L-Shape: Place the 21" *Header Piece* near the headboard of the bed with the *Angled Side* facing the headboard. (see #3) Next, add the 42" piece to form an L-shape along the side of the bed with the *Angled Side* facing up and in toward the baby. To place on the opposite side of the bed, just turn the long piece around so the *Angled Side* is facing up and in toward the baby with the 21" *Header Piece* positioned as directed above.



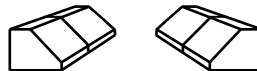
U-Shape: Place the 3 pieces in the center of the bed in a U-shape in the same manner as above. (see #4) The 42" pieces can also be turned *Angled Side* down if you prefer a bumper with a lower height (for the center bed position only).

Travel Bumpers

Travel Bumpers are cut in half for easier packing and handling. Place the half pieces together in a straight line to form the full size bumper as shown and follow the instructions above for set up.

Infant Co-Sleeping L-Shape

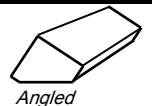

To separate 2 sleepers in a bed: Place the Bed Bug Bumper™ between children with the angled side facing down on the mattress under the fitted sheet or mattress cover.



Cut or add any length

You may purchase additional pieces of this foam and place them in line with the Bed Bug Bumper™ to extend the length. The Bed Bug Bumper™ can also be cut to meet your size requirements. The easiest way to cut the foam is with an electric knife.
